His recent academic leadership efforts at UCF resulted in a new Classification of Instructional Programs (CIP) code identifying the Kinesiology programs as part of the STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) disciplines by the state of Florida, and statelevel approval of the standalone Kinesiology Ph.D. program housed within the College of Health Profession and Sciences. Dr. Fukuda has been a Certified Strength & Conditioning Specialist since 2008, a Senior Associate Editor for the Journal of Strength and Conditioning Research since 2017, and received NSCA Fellow status in 2021.

"Congratulations to Dr. Fukuda for this well-deserved award," said Michael Massik, NSCA Executive Director. "He has changed many lives and exemplifies what it is to be an NSCA professional. We are proud to have him as a member."
